

FORMER WHITE HOUSE COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTOR ANTHONY SCARAMUCCI AND DEPUTY LABOUR PARTY LEADER TOM WATSON ANNOUNCED AS UPCOMING GUESTS ON UNSPUN WITH MATT FORDE



Deputy Leader of the Labour Party **Tom Watson** is set to be the next guest on *Unspun with Matt Forde*, broadcast at 10pm on Sunday 11th of March on Dave. He will be followed by former White House Communications Director and member of Trump's inner circle **Anthony Scaramucci** on Sunday 18th, now reportedly on the list of people banned from inside the White House. Both will be joining **Matt** for an in-depth interview alongside up-to-the-minute political comedy and commentary on the week's events.

Series four has seen former Labour Advisor turned stand-up comedian **Matt Forde** offer his sharp take on breaking news and current affairs alongside delving in to the more human side of Britain's leading political figures through in-studio interviews with **Alastair Campbell**, **Yvette Cooper**, **Lord Adonis**, **Vince Cable**, **Nadine Dorries** and **Justine Greening**.

Unspun With Matt Forde has been nominated for *Best Entertainment Programme* at the Broadcast Digital Awards, and over the last three series, **Matt** has enjoyed guests including **Tony Blair**, **Harriet Harman**, **Robin Cook**, and **Anne Widdicombe**. For the first time, this highly

topical political comedy chat show is being recorded on the same evening of transmission, and extended in-depth version, **Unspun XL with Matt Forde**, is broadcast on the channel later that week, taking the run to 8x30' and 8x60'. In addition to **Matt** tackling some of the biggest stories in politics including EU divorce bills, Westminster hatches and dispatches and the impending impeachment of **Donald Trump** (the last one might be wishful thinking), he has also be joined by special guest comedians to unpick the week's events and no episode would be complete without the backing of the country's only rock band made up of current and former politicians, **MP4**.
