Acclaimed character comedian SIMON BRODKIN is the writer and star of BBC Three's ratings success Lee Nelson's Well Good Show. LEE NELSON has a brand new nationwide live tour kicking off on 28th April 2013 and appeared on this year's Let's Dance for... Comic Relief (BBC One), getting to the final and making him the only person to perform on the show twice (he performed Wham's 'Club Tropicana' in tiny white trunks in 2011).
