



RUSSELL HOWARD'S FIRST EVER LIVE STAND-UP TV SHOW TO AIR ON COMEDY CENTRAL THIS SPRING

One of the UK's most successful comedians, RUSSELL HOWARD is set to host his first ever stand-up TV show on Comedy Central. The 10-part series, Russell Howard's Stand Up Central, will launch on Wednesday 29th April at 9pm.

Written and presented by the hugely popular comedian, the series is being filmed in front of a live audience at the intimate and legendary Electric Ballroom in Camden, featuring performances from RUSSELL, as well as two handpicked stand-up guests each episode. In addition to performing new and exclusive material, RUSSELL will delve into questions from viewers on social media and interact with members of the audience.

In each episode, RUSSELL is joined by a headline and support act, invited to showcase their talents. These include DOC BROWN (Derek, The Inbetweeners), ROISIN CONATY (Man Down), ROB DELANEY (Catastrophe), CARL DONNELLY (Edinburgh Comedy Award nominee), NICK HELM (Uncle), ALEX HORNE (The Horne Section), ANDREW MAXWELL (Conspiracy Road Trip), SARA PASCOE (W1A), KATHERINE RYAN (Room 101, Have I got News For You) and JOE WILKINSON (Him & Her, 8 Out of 10 Cats Does Countdown).

RUSSELL HOWARD said, *"I'm really looking forward to hosting the show. We've got loads of great new comics on and...It's also quite close to my house."*

Last year, RUSSELL embarked on his brand new sell-out world tour Wonderbox, performing to over 285,000 fans at 40 shows across the UK and Ireland, including four consecutive nights at London's Royal Albert Hall, as well as sold-out runs in the USA, Australia and New Zealand. He is now the biggest UK comedian on Facebook with over 3.1 million fans and over a million on Twitter.
